

## Part A.

Introduction: The Junior Camp had a successful first season. Housing, feeding, and program activities were not unduly hampered although the plant was not nearly ready by the opening day of Camp. Essential facilities were adequate, and the Camp program started from the first day with building, improvements and additional facilities being added from day to day. Actually the day by day growth in the camp plant and program served to add to the general tone of the program and morale of the counselors and campers.

## Part B.

Administration:

1. Food Services: Excellent cooking by Lee and Mary Singleton. Above the average dining hall staff provided good service and kept dining hall and kitchen in excellent sanitary condition. Inventory enclosed as Annex B 1.

2. Health: Overall very good. Mrs. Charles Whitten did an excellent job. No colds more than slight, and very few at end of season. Infected sores on legs, faces, arms were chief source of concern. Daily hot showers with soap probably held these to minimum. Also emphasis was placed on drying well and clean clothes. Still more Counselor co-operation is needed along this line. Inventory left in Infirmary in Black book, with linen list tacked on linen cabinet door. No medical supplies left in the Infirmary.

3. Buildings and Equipment: Well suited and adequate to support full camp program for twelve units of sixty boys only. Additional facilities and equipment covered under Part D, suggestions and recommendations for next year. Inventories covered under Part C, Program Activities.

4. Staff: No counselor below average. Majority were excellent counselors, both in program and cabin, and a few were superior in performance of their duty. Counselor rating will be covered in confidence report. Morale seemed to be high throughout, and a more congenial group would be hard to find. This includes the dining hall staff, cooks, Nurse, Karen Johnson as well as the cabin and program staff.

5. Sports and Games:

- a. Very active program in small games (tetherball, box hockey, horseshoes, chinning, peg balancing), as well as in whiffle ball, soft ball, football, soccer, tennis and sticks. Tumbling and wrestling also active after mat received.
- b. Several field days, organized game periods,, and two tournaments were conducted.

6. Woodcraft:

- a. Well conducted program responsible for 8 cook-outs, including 1 overnight hike each five weeks.
- b. Council Ring started.

7. Horseback:

- a. Excellent instruction on all levels. Classes well attended, with practically all missed rides made-up.
- b. Two riding exhibitions showing the superior instruction the more advanced riders received.

8. Evening Programs and Special Programs: (See Hobachee File - Annex A)


- a. Generally 1 night each week for the following: council ring program, cabin night, games night, cook-out, free night, special program and Friendship Council.
- b. Special features: Puppet show, Circus, Water Olympics, Vanderbilt Estate Trip (2), "Up to These Hills" (2), Indoor Track Meet, 4th July Celebration, Birthday Party, Old Sequoyan Club Inductions, Bald Knob Hike, Craftsmen's Fair Trip, Stunts Night, and certain special programs with Senior Camp.
- c. Sunday Services and Friendships Councils: Both services each Sunday, as well as Morning Watch and Cabin Devotions, were worthwhile and contributed much to the summer's experience.

(Note: Horseback classes rode 3 times each week, 1 hour each class per ride. Archery, Crafts, Lake, Nature, Sports and Woodcraft were required activities for three periods each day during week days, each camper repeating a single activity every other day. On Saturday a camper could chose the activity he wished to attend.)

Part D.

Suggestions and Recommendations for next year.

1. No expansion for the 1958 season at least beyond the 60 boy limit. The dining hall will not adequately handle two more tables, and our program facilities should be tried one more year at least, on the originally planned top limit of sixty boys.
2. Two overnight trips per five week period for each cabin group.
